BLUE TRAIL

Distance: 1.8 Km
Rating: Easy-Moderate

This popular trail offers a scenic walk through a spectacular canyon along Fairmont Creek. Cross the bridge located behind the hot pools ticket office to the RV Park. Turn right to find the first trail head marker. Follow the markers either down into the canyon or stay on top following along its edge, the trails meet up further down the canyon.

WHITE TRAIL

Distance: 2.5 Km
Rating: Easy-Moderate

Enjoy walking through forested and open areas to a scenic outlook. This trail begins in the RV Park and offers excellent interpretive information and impressive views of the valley. View Columbia Lake to the south, the Hoodoos formations to the west, and to the north see the Columbia River and its flourishing wetlands.

ORANGE TRAIL

Distance: 4 Km
Rating: Moderate

This trail begins off the RV Park entrance road beside Fairmont Creek. It meanders through a thick Douglas fir forest and opens up into grassland area. The trail connects onto the White Trail to a stunning view of the Columbia Valley. You may also connect onto one of the Light Green Trails to loop back to the resort or down towards Columbia Lake (difficult bike, moderate hike).

YELLOW TRAIL

Distance: 1.8 km
Rating: Moderate (one steep section)

Allows a scenic walk to the Fairmont Market.

LIGHT GREEN

Existing trails that are not signed.

RED TRAIL

Distance: 9 Km
Rating: Moderate (long with elevation)

Challenge yourself on this spectacular day hike and you will be rewarded with beautiful mountain scenery. Catch the beginning of this trail behind the Historical Bath House then follow the trail markers across the ski hill road. The trail then veers to the right through a green gate. After 2Km / 45 min. the trail forks – head left for a shorter hike, or right for a longer hike through switchbacks. Any way you choose will offer amazing views of the Columbia Valley.

GREEN TRAIL

Distance: 4 Km
Rating: Moderate (switchbacks and one short steep section)

This wide trail starts above the Historical Bath Houses and heads North. Turn left at the fork to find a wide switchback trail through a beautiful forest that leads to a bridge and pump house. Head up in elevation on a short and steep trail to return back in a loop or head west onto the road to return back to the Lodge.
