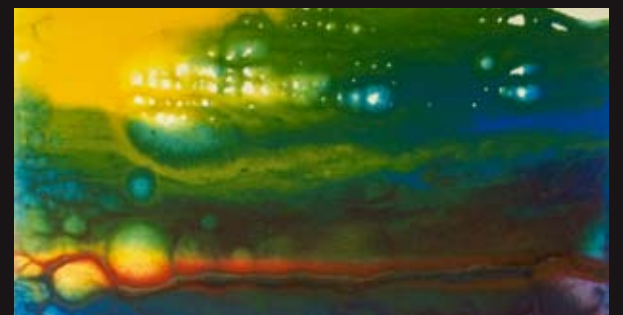
## Featured Artists

**Ryan Bavin - Photography** - I received my first camera for my twelfth birthday while on a family backpacking trip near the famous Bugaboo mountains northwest of Invermere. Over the years I have worked with film, especially black and white film, developing and enlarging my own photos. Often arbitrary colours are used, and layers of media, such as acrylic, tempera, gesso, conté, charcoal, chalk pastel, pigments, etc, may be added or removed from the canvas.
